## Rail tracks – Important information

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You have registered for a display site on the outdoor rail tracks at InnoTrans. In making your preparations for this trade show you are requested to observe a number of important points to ensure the smooth running of the event:

### Tracks:

- ▶ We are offering especially favourable terms for track-bound exhibits, which are calculated not in accordance with the area occupied but solely by linear metres. However, these special terms apply only to rail exhibits.
- ▶ The area around the vehicle is not form part of the reserved area. Nevertheless, you are welcome to install the following items in the immediate vicinity to provide access to the vehicle:
  - steps or, if possible, ramps to assist the disabled. Please inform us about all plans you have regarding this matter.
  - 1 pylon/information board providing details about the vehicle (max. width 1m)  
If additional space is needed please submit an application for the required display area. Bookings for flagpoles can be made through [advertising@mb-capital-services.com](mailto:advertising@mb-capital-services.com) or by telephoning +49 (0)30 3038-2525.
- ▶ Electricity supply: Traction current is available on the rail track display areas (from power supply points with sockets with the following ratings: RIC 800A, 1000V, 16 2/3 Hz). We can also provide three-phase current AC 400V and alternating current AC 230V (3.3kW/16A). No other types of current or voltage are supplied on the site and cannot be made available. Please ensure that you apply in good time for all your power supply requirements to enable the necessary arrangements to be made. ([Electrical Installations](#))
- ▶ All rail vehicles must be secured against unintentional movement at all times, but positioned so that they can be shunted. Please ensure that your vehicles are provided with sufficient stop blocks to enable rolling stock to be effectively immobilised.
- ▶ Any deliveries to be made by rail must be registered by 31 July 2022 with DB Schenker Rail. You will be sent the relevant forms when you receive confirmation of the location of your display.
- ▶ If heavy loads are being delivered on the road Messe Berlin GmbH, Mr. Klaus Seipold, must be notified (tel. +49 (0)30 3038-4087 or [Klaus.Seipold@messe-berlin.de](mailto:Klaus.Seipold@messe-berlin.de)). A date and time and a location must be arranged with Mr. Seipold for the loading and unloading of the rolling stock (stating the space required for ramps or cranes). Please note that heavy transporters must be removed from the exhibition grounds immediately after unloading of the exhibit.

The use of cranes and forklift trucks is reserved for Messe Berlin's contract forwarding agents / contractors. Exceptions must be agreed in advance with Messe Berlin, subject to approval and charges. --> Item 5.12 Technical Guidelines Messe Berlin GmbH

### Outdoor areas:

- ▶ As is the case in the exhibition halls, stand boundaries must be strictly observed. Any additional areas for exhibits, tables, chairs or parasols must be booked in advance and will be invoiced as stand areas after the event.
- ▶ Two-storied areas will be charged, analogous to the hall booths, with 135,- €/ sqm.
- ▶ Unless arrangements have been made to the contrary outdoor stands are row stands which are open on one side.
- ▶ Storage and refrigerated containers must be applied for separately, using the relevant forms, which are available from our [web shop](#).
